



CLEAN-UP ACTIVITIES AT YOUR LOCAL NATURE SPOT

Local residents are invited to come along and help clean up their Local Nature Spot. They will not only improve the look of their local area but will assist in the quest to demonstrate the extent of the problem and determine the sources of rubbish in their local bushland.

In 2007 a community survey conducted as part of the Local Nature Spot project in 15 areas near bushland reserves showed that 84% of respondents agreed that dumping of building material and rubbish was a problem or threat to their natural area and 79% stated the same about disposing of garden waste.

Identification of the sources of rubbish will enable introduction of effective strategies to reduce the problem specific to each site.
