6.1 Support for A Forum into Environmental Damage, Vandalism and Anti-Social Behaviour in Regional Parks

Background

The Regional Parks have ongoing issues of escalating damage due to illegal access, severe damage to property and theft of flora that is impacting on the ecological values of the sites and the protection of the conservation values going forward.

The Beeliar Regional Park Advisory Committee Chair Professor Philip Jennings would like a forum to be convened with the Western Australian Local Government Association (WALGA) to explore for some protection measures for the Regional Parks.

RESOLUTION

- 1. WALGA to establish a working group that includes representation from Local Government, Regional Parks and other landholders (DPLH, Water Corp etc.) to source funding options and identify projects to address site security, environmental damage, vandalism and anti-social behaviour affecting Regional Parks at a regional scale.
- 2. WALGA to advocate to state government bodies/departments to maintain access control to Regional Park land which they are responsible for.
